Breakfast Blend

Featuring a bespoke blend of Assam and Ceylon teas specifically chosen to create the perfect cup of breakfast tea. An ethical and sustainably sourced tea with classic, smoky, and oak flavour.

Assam

Most Assam is grown at or near sea level, in a warm, wet climate, and is known for its body, briskness, malty flavour, and strong, bright colour. It is the weather conditions and terrain that contribute to the distinct malty flavour. The Wogan Assam tea is an alternative to breakfast tea. It's a full bodied, rich tea with malty flavour notes.

Earl Grey

A high quality low grown tea mixed with natural bergamot oil creating a heavenly aromatic experience whilst finishing with smooth, citrus notes.

Milk Oolong

Created on the misty slopes of Taiwan, Milk
Oolong is a unique product of nature. It holds a
dense, creamy aroma and a warm, seductive
sweetness.

It is recommended to be served without milk or sugar. Another alternative is to add a few drops of lemon juice to the tea.

Lovers Leap

Lovers' Leap teas are reputed for their delicate and elegant characteristics. The tea absorbs the fragrances and when infused it bears a remarkable golden, light green infusion. The flavours are bright, crisp and clean – the pleasant mentholated undertones will leave your taste buds tingling! Moreover, it was the only tea to be served at the HM Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee in 2012 – a tea for those who enjoy the finer things in life!
