Mara Moura, Godello – Monterrei £39

From Galicia near Portugal, this structured white has white fruit, strong minerality, floral and balsamic notes, and a long finish. It showcases Spain's best fresh whites.

Luis Cañas, Viura 'Viñas Viejas' – Rioja £45

Rich and complex with dark fruit, spice, and hints of oak. Smooth tannins and a long, elegant finish. A standout Rioja from old vines.

Torrojal Albariño – Rías Baixas £45

An elegant, Atlantic-influenced Albariño with a bouquet of ripe stone fruits and white florals. The palate is silky and precise, featuring a saline minerality and a sophisticated, fresh finish.

England

Three Choirs, May Hill – Gloucestershire £39

A medium-sweet, full-bodied white with vibrant grapefruit and ripe citrus aromas. Honeyed notes complement the crisp acidity, resulting in a refreshing, well-balanced wine. Crafted from hand-picked grapes from 10-20-year-old vines, grown on sandy loam soils with minimal intervention.

Budureasca, Premium Fume – Dealu Mare £45

Dry white wine with a smoky character. Made from Sauvignon Blanc grapes, it offers crisp notes of citrus and green apple. Crafted by Budureasca's Premium Collection from the Dealu Mare region.

Australia

Tooma River, Chardonnay – Tumbarumba £33

Dry Chardonnay with vibrant acidity. It features flavors of ripe pear, citrus, and subtle oak. Produced by Tooma River in the Tumbarumba region.

Peter Lehmann, Layers – Adelaide Hills £45

A refreshing blend of Pinot Gris, Muscat, Gewürztraminer, and Semillon. With tropical and citrus aromas, hints of spice, and a crisp, zesty finish.

Masseria Settearchi, Fiano Salento – Puglia £33

An elegant example of this type of grape variety coming from the heart of the Cape Winelands. It is a fresh, dry Chenin with citrus aromas leading to orchard and tropical fruits on the palate, well balanced by crisp acidity.

Ken Forrester, Chenin Blanc 'FMC' – Stellenbosch £90

The FMC Chenin Blanc by award-winning producer Ken Forrester is a rich, complex wine with intense notes of dried apricot, honey, and vanilla, balanced by vibrant acidity and a luxurious, creamy finish.

Languedoc, France

A classic Mediterranean blend of Cinsault and Syrah. Delicate pale pink with elegant aromas of fresh strawberry and grapefruit zest. Crisp, lively, and incredibly refreshing.

Preignes, Grains de Grenache **£8/10/12** **£34**

Languedoc, France

From a family vineyard, located between Béziers and Agde, in heart of the Languedoc, the vineyard Preignes and its medieval castle belongs to the Vic Family, five generations which have succeeded each other to produce renowned wines. This wine it's a beautiful salmon pink rosé with a very floral nose. Dry with delicate summer fruit flavours, on the palate fresh and enveloping.

Catalunya, Spain

Más Amor or More Love echoes the livelihood of Barcelona. Displaying an intense colour, aromatically it echoes citrus fruits and wild strawberries. A wine with a noticeable but pleasant acidity, light and fresh with intense citric notes like lime and grapefruit, red cherries, and peppermint leaves.

Woodchester Valley, Pinot Noir Rosé **£51**

Cotswolds, England

Woodchester Valley Vineyard was first planted in 2007 by the Shiner family, starting with a single acre plot in Amberley in the Cotswolds. They specialise in estate-made wines, having built their winery on site in 2016. This varietal rose is a flavoursome, dry pink wine with raspberry and strawberry aromas and a zingy, crisp palate full of punchy waxed lemons, bittersweet grapefruit, and tangy rhubarb, rounding out in a soft and refreshing finish.

Rimauresq Cru Classé Rosé **£55**

Côtes de Provence, France

Rimauresq Cru Classé Rosé is a classic Provençal rosé from Grenache, Cinsault, Rolle, Syrah, and Mourvèdre. Salmon pink, fresh and clean, with spicy red-fruit and herbal notes. One of the select Côtes de Provence estates awarded Cru Classé status in 1955, Rimauresq's diverse terroirs and microclimate produce elegant wines that reflect the character of the region.

A beautifully expressive Pinot Noir with vibrant acidity and delicate aromas of red cherry, raspberry, and subtle earthiness. Crafted by Cramele Recas, one of Romania's most esteemed wineries, this wine offers a silky texture and an elegant finish.

Maison Sinnae, Côtes du Rhône **£8/10/12** **£34**

Chuslan, France

A classic Rhône blend with deep, inky hues and brilliant brightness. Bursting with ripe blackberries, dark cherries, and a hint of spice, this wine delivers powerful yet refined fruit concentration with a velvety, well-rounded mouthfeel.

Gran Sasso, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo **£8/10/12** **£34**

Abruzzo, Italy

A captivating Italian red with luscious layers of ripe plums, black cherries, and wild blackberries. Subtle spice and earthy undertones add depth, while soft tannins create a smooth and lingering finish. A refined yet approachable choice.

Wild & Wilder, The Opportunist, Shiraz **£9/11/13** **£37**

Langhorne Creek, Australia

A bold and indulgent Shiraz with layers of dark cherry, ripe blackcurrant, and espresso, lifted by notes of dark chocolate and fresh peppermint. Full-bodied yet beautifully balanced, this wine offers a luxurious, lingering finish.

Los Haroldos Estate, Malbec **£9/11/13** **£37**

Mendoza, Argentina

Deep and inviting, this Malbec unveils rich flavors of blackberry, plum, and dark chocolate, complemented by hints of vanilla and spice. Smooth tannins and a long, velvety finish reflect the craftsmanship of the renowned Los Haroldos winery.

Château des Gravieres – Bordeaux **£39**

With many prizes won, this deep garnet-red wine, has a slightly woody and toasty nose and aromas of prunes and liquorice. Fleshy robust and well balanced in the mouth with a firm, lengthy finish.

Domaine de Montvac, Arabesque – Vacqueras **£50**

Offers balanced elegance with Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre. Its delicate structure delivers pure, intense redcurrant and licorice aromas, without oak. The palate is refined with fine tannins, balanced acidity, and lasting presence.

Domaine Brusset, Gigondas – Côtes du Rhone **£76**

The 'Les Hauts de Montmirail' is a structured red blend primarily made from Grenache, Mourvèdre, and Syrah. It is characterized by a rich, chocolatey profile accented by ripe blackberries and peppery spice, presenting pronounced earthy notes alongside straightforward characteristics of cherry and plum.

Jaeger-Defaix, Rully Clos du Chapitre – Burgundy **£90**

Clos du Chapitre is a fine, elegant Pinot Noir with a classic Burgundian style. It features red fruit aromas, violets, and cherry, with supple tannins and refreshing acidity.

Domaine Maillard Père & Fils Aloxe-Corton – Burgundy **£109**

Bright purple with a bouquet of red fruit, dark notes, and black cherry. Ripe yet sensual, with excellent length, delicate floral hints, and a touch of minerality. This Aloxe-Corton is an elegant Pinot Noir, showcasing the Côte de Beaune at its best.

Pommard Les Perrières – Côte de Beaune **£109**

Vibrant with a hint of mahogany, this Pommard AOC offers wild berries, black fruits, and spice. The medium-bodied palate features strawberries, cherry, mushrooms, and earthy notes, with intense tannins and a firm, clean finish.

Spain

Pedrera Monastrell – Jumilla **£30**

Produced at 700 m altitude, this young unoaked wine has appealing aromas of dark red cherry and ripe plum. A bright, fruit-forward style with pure bramble and mocha characters, rounded tannins and wonderfully smooth in the mouth.

Borsao Selección Tinto – Campo de Borja **£33**

Made from old vines in the hills of Campo de Borja, this blend of Garnacha, Syrah, and Tempranillo offers vibrant red berry flavors and a smooth finish.

Viña Marichalar 'Crianza' – Rioja **£39**

Vina Marichalar Rioja Crianza is a smooth, medium-bodied red wine with notes of red berries, oak, and spice, aged in oak barrels for a balanced finish.

Italy

Vigneti Zabu, Nero d'Avola – Sicily **£34**

Zabu Nero d'Avola from Sicily offers bold flavors of ripe plum, dark cherries, and subtle spice. It's a smooth, full-bodied red, perfect for rich, hearty dishes.

Montresor, "Urban Park" Appassimento – Veneto **£41**

This Veneto appassimento red, made from Amarone grapes, offers bright berry and black cherry aromas with a hint of spice. The palate has fresh cherry and ripe bramble fruit, oak complexity, supple tannins, and a sweet, balanced finish.

Mandarossa, Timperosse – Sicily **£42**

Mandarossa, from the unspoiled southwest of Sicily, is dark and intense with aromas of cherry, plum, and red apple, plus a hint of ginger. The palate features ripe, plummy fruit with soft tannins and a long finish of stewed fruit flavors.

Produttori Di Manduria, Primitivo Lirica – Puglia **£50**

Lirica Primitivo from Manduria is a medium ruby red with ripe dark fruits, cherry, plum, and sweet spices on the nose. The palate is round and textured, with balanced freshness, elegant tannins, and a long, spicy finish.

Fontanafredda, Marne Brune Nebbiolo d'Alba – Piemonte **£57**

Nebbiolo Marne Brune features floral and wild fruit aromas, with a dry, almond-like taste. It is a deep ruby red with faint garnet tints.

Fontanafredda, Barolo Serralunga d'Alba – Piedmonte **£96**

Barolo Serralunga d'Alba is a lush, garnet-red wine with dark fruit and dried cherry flavors. It features intense vanilla, spice, rose, and underbrush aromas. The taste is dry, soft, full-bodied, and velvety with a long-lasting finish.

Brolo dei Giusti, Amarone della Valpolicella – Veneto **£128**

A premium red wine with a dry, persistent finish and red fruit flavors from three Broli vineyards. It features a complex, intense palate with smooth tannins, a warming sensation, and a long, lingering finish. This wine has great aging potential.

Argentina

Kaiken, Terroir Series Vistaflores Cabernet Sauvignon – Mendoza **£34**

This elegant blend, deep red with ruby hues, offers ripe red fruit, black fruit, spices, chocolate, and coffee aromas. On the palate, Petit Verdot's firm tannins and fruity flavors lead to a soft, elegant finish.

Humberto Canale, Estate Malbec – Patagonia **£35**

Showcases Patagonian terroir with a refined style. It features complex red berry, eucalyptus, spice, and black pepper notes, enhanced by oak aging. Full-bodied and structured, it is an irresistible expression of Argentine Malbec.

Chile

Norte Chico, Merlot – Central Valley **£33**

Crafted by an esteemed producer in Chile's Central Valley, showcases ripe plum and cherry flavors with a soft, approachable finish, reflecting the region's ideal climate for Merlot.

Portugal

Casa Ferreirinha, Vinha Grande Douro – Douro Valley **£42**

Vinha Grande is the second oldest wine of the Douro Valley (behind Barca Velha) and its heritage is noticeable in every sip. An elegant, complex wine with the structure of a fine Bordeaux exhibiting flavours of blackcurrant, leather and subtle oak spice.

Uruguay

Bresemi, Pequeñas Colecciones Tannat – Canelones **£45**

A great example of Uruguayan Tannat from a fourth generation family producer. Rich black fruits with hints of chocolate, coffee and liquorice. Fresh acidity and fine tannins on the persistent finish.

USA

De Loach, Heritage Reserve Pinot Noir – California **£51**

De Loach Heritage Reserve Pinot Noir is an elegant California Pinot Noir with cherry and strawberry flavors, accented by subtle spice and earthiness.

Lebanon

Domaine des Tourelles, Marquis des Beys – Bekaa Valley **£72**

Marquis des Beys Red from Domaine des Tourelles is a refined Cabernet-Syrah blend with soft oak aging, offering bramble fruit, spicy chocolate notes, and fine tannins.

Moldova

Purcari, Negru de Purcari – Purcari **£82**

Negru de Purcari is a deep ruby wine praised by the Queen of England. A blend of 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Saperavi, and 10% Rara Neagra, it offers red and black fruit flavors, spice from French oak aging, full-bodied richness, fine tannins, and earthy notes from bottle aging.
